



IB STUDY TRIP RULES OF CONDUCT

The IBO Mission Statement emphasizes that the students should be encouraged to become “inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect”.

This runs a red thread through the syllabus of the IB Diploma Programme, and to further contribute to the fulfilment of this aim, Birkerød Gymnasium sends their IB students on a study trip to a European city. The purpose of this trip is to enhance the students’ understanding of Europe’s political and cultural institutions through on-site visits and to catalyze the students’ process of formation by adding a new perspective to the subject specific studies they do at home in school.

The rules of conduct listed below are constructed to provide a framework to address the above mentioned aims, and to ensure that the students can travel safely.

1. All participants in the study trip are expected to behave responsibly and to help and support each other.
2. The study trip is a study trip, not a normal tourist holiday. Therefore active and punctual participation in all study activities is mandatory.
3. All participants in the study trip will show respect for the culture of the places they visit. This includes appropriate clothing and appropriate behaviour during the planned activities and at all other times.
4. At the hotel, everyone must behave civilized and not disturb the other guests. No ghetto blasters!
5. Alcohol:
 - a. Consumption of alcohol is not allowed during the study activities
 - b. Consumption of alcohol is only allowed with moderation
 - c. Strong alcohol is not allowed at any time.
6. No student walks alone at any time
7. All groups going out on their own must report to a teacher.
8. All instructions and directions given by the teachers must be adhered to at any time.

Students failing to adhere to the above study rules may be sent home at their own expense without further notice, and may, in grave cases, be expelled from the school.
