



Rules of Conduct at Birkerød Gymnasium

In a "gymnasium" many different people are gathered in a relatively small area. Therefore, it is necessary to have some rules of conduct that everybody must adhere to. They are as follows:

1. Show **consideration** in your general behaviour, and show **respect** for the school, the teachers, and your class mates.
2. **Smoking** is only allowed downstairs **outside** the buildings
3. It is prohibited to bring, take, trade, or be under the influence of **any kind of drugs** on the school premises.
4. It is prohibited to consume or be under the influence of **alcohol** on the school premises. At school functions, the headmaster may allow the sale of beer and wine. If the teachers in charge find it necessary, students may be denied admittance or may be sent home.
5. **Food** and **beverages** must not be consumed in the corridors, nor in the class rooms.
6. **Cellphones** (mobilphones) must be turned off in class.
7. Each one of you is responsible for **clearing up** after yourselves before leaving a room. This also goes for outside.
8. **Graffiti** and other damage to furniture and other equipment is vandalism and can be prosecuted.
9. **Bicycles** must only be parked in the designated areas outside or in the basement. Mopeds and motorbikes are to be parked at the far end of the car parking lot – near the stadium. Cars must only be parked in the painted bays in the parking lot.
10. **Information** is posted on the relevant bulletin boards. In special cases notices may be posted elsewhere – but only with permission from the office.
11. On school trips as well as on the school premises, the rules given by the teacher in charge must be obeyed.

Consequences of breaking the rules of conduct:

The headmaster decides which measures are to be taken (talks, warnings, temporary or permanent expulsion from the school).
